**Confirmation of Transitional Membership**

As the governance and oversight body for the International Code of Conduct Private Security Service Providers (“the Code”), the Board of Directors of the International Code of Conduct for Private Security Service Providers Association (ICoCA) has reviewed the application and supporting materials submitted by Securitas AB and found them to be in full satisfaction of the Association Membership Requirements for Transitional Membership.
